The mill yard will provide delights such as beef wellington, strudel, spinach and broccoli puffs, barbecued ribs, brisket, chicken, cowboy beans, hamburgers, french fries, turkey legs, corn dogs, and several delightful Chinese entrees. For snacks don't miss the 100 layer Helmut's apple and cheese strudel, funnel cakes, homemade peanut brittle, honey kettle popcorn and a fresh limeade or lemonade.

The doors at War Eagle Mill will be opened wide to sample and sell our fresh breads along with our organic whole grain flours, meals, mixes, sugarless fruit-spreads and more. We will be milling corn each day on first floor. Our 150 year-old mill-stones are powered by the only 18 foot undershot waterwheel in operation in the entire country. Ask our miller to tell you the story of the mill's founding family. Don't miss the second floor gift shop with its cast iron cookware, stoneware dishes, uniquely crafted jewelry, quilts and custom knives. The Bean Palace Restaurant will feature beans and cornbread with

fine corn relish along with hot black berry, pecan and sugarless apple cobblers for a delightful dessert.
